DISTINGUISHING JOB CHARACTERISTICS

Provides academic and/or behavioral interventions to students with mild-to-moderate needs in grades 7-12, supports general education curriculum and instruction in conjunction with general education teaching staff. Engages in progress monitoring of IEP goals and gathers baseline data to inform new IEP goals, coordinates and conducts annual review IEP meetings and IEP amendment meetings, and collaborates with State Support Team 10 consultants, facility staff, therapists, MCJCS Special Education Coordinator, representatives of school districts of residence, and other school and community stakeholders. The position reports to the MCJCS Special Education Coordinator and is assigned to Nicholas Residential Treatment Center.

QUALIFICATIONS

Minimum of a Bachelor’s degree in Special Education or related field is required.
