ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Judge Anthony Capizzi, Administrative Judge of the Montgomery County Juvenile Court, hereby issues this Administrative Order in the continuing response to the public health emergency created by the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). As an essential government function, the Montgomery County Juvenile Court will continue to comply with the safety guidelines that the Ohio Department of Public Health and the Montgomery County Health Department provide in order to maintain a safe working environment for Montgomery County Juvenile Court staff and the general public that we serve.

THEREFORE, given the recent changes to state and federal guidelines, it is hereby ORDERED that effective Wednesday, June 2, 2021:

- 1.) All Juvenile Court staff working in the secure areas of Detention and the Intervention Center shall be required to wear facial coverings while at work. The COVID-19 screening processes will continue in these areas.
- 2.) All individuals appearing in court rooms may be required to wear facial coverings at the discretion of the Judicial Officer of that particular Court Room.
- 3.) Outside of the areas outlined above fully vaccinated staff and other individuals will have the option to wear a facial covering while inside a Juvenile Court facility.
- 4.) Additionally, the Juvenile Court will maintain the recommended safe health and social distancing practices while in any of the Juvenile Court facilities.
- 5.) This Order and all its provisions shall remain in effect until further order of this Court through its Administrative Judge.
