**DISTINGUISHING JOB CHARACTERISTICS**

Responsible for the direct supervision and management of youth and staff members in a secure 24-hour, 7 day per week facility for juvenile offenders; in a manner consistent with established program objectives, policy and procedures. Directs the activities, programs and care for juvenile offenders. Maintains a safe environment for staff and clients. This person is responsible for assigning and reviewing staff work, training and providing ongoing feedback regarding staff development and performance while maintaining documentation and administering corrective actions as needed. Occasionally performs duties and responsibilities assigned to Youth Specialists. The employee will perform duties that are supervisory in nature and other responsibilities specific to the shift's needs. This person will actively participate and interact with youth in a therapeutic manner, provide guidance and instruction, and serve as a role model for youth and staff at the highest level of professionalism and integrity. The person in this position must work a flexible schedule that is subject to change with little notice and will include regularly scheduled times on weekends and holidays.

**QUALIFICATIONS**

Bachelor's Degree Preferred. An appropriate combination of education, training, course work and experience may qualify the applicant. While not a requirement for consideration, those applicants with supervisory experience will be given preference. General knowledge of behavior theories and treatment models appropriate to a delinquent population. Knowledge of safety and security practices within an institutional environment. Must have a valid Ohio Driver's License with acceptable driving record.

Ability to document identity and employment eligibility within three (3) days of original appointment as a condition of employment in compliance with Immigration Reform and Control Act requirements.
