DISTINGUISHING JOB CHARACTERISTICS

An employee assigned to this classification demonstrates competency in one or more specialized areas including alcohol or drugs, gender specific, sex offender, mental health, learning disabled or other, and serves as a department and a Court resource in specialized area. This position will utilize curriculums to address and improve criminogenic thinking, motivation to change, anger management, social skills, decision-making, and family relationships. This Supervisor will administer a multimodal psycho educational intervention designed to alter the behavior of chronically aggressive adolescents in a secured correctional group setting. This staff member provides supervision to assigned staff in the performance of their job duties and responsibilities. The supervisor coordinates admissions to the program and referral to services within the program. Employee will work closely with contracted providers and ODYS staff. Employee may occasionally have to travel out of state and will respond to emergency situations while in the facility and/or during off-hours

QUALIFICATIONS

Bachelor's degree in psychology, sociology, criminal justice, social work or related field with 3 years experience in the juvenile justice system. Demonstrated skill and expertise in a specialized area pertinent to Juvenile Justice. ***Experience working with groups required.*** A Master's Degree may be substituted for up to two years experience at the Director's discretion. Able to pass a criminal background check.
