The person in this position will be expected to supervise the work of Youth Specialists and Control Desk staff, coordinate treatment, management of security efforts with all other departments, actively participate and interact with youth in a therapeutic manner, provide guidance and instruction on the delivery of the treatment approach, and serve as a role model for youth and staff at the highest level of professionalism and integrity. The person in this position must work a flexible schedule that is subject to change with little notice and will include regularly scheduled times on weekends and holidays.
