Intervention & Detention Services

The Court provides a secure holding facility for youth who are being held while waiting disposition of their cases.



Probation & Education Services

Court staff supervise youth while attempting to expose them to various cultural, educational and recreational activities to broaden their horizons.



Volunteer Services

Court Appointed Special Advocates serve as the voice of youth in the court process. Natural Helpers serve as mentors to youth in Probation.



C.A.S. & N.R.T.C.

The Center for Adolescent Services provides a safe a secure learning and treatment environment. The Nicholas Residential Treatment Center serves youth who've had increasing involvement with the Court.
